Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Please say a prayer for Fr. Cesar Ageas. He became pastor at St. Joseph's in Auburn after I left there as a seminarian and was there when I celebrated my first Mass. He retired last year but just found out he has stage 4 pancreatic cancer and there is no treatment available at this point. He is on hospice. Please also pray for Deacon Ed and Deacon Jaime. They both would appreciate some prayers.

Last week we had a meeting for both St. Mary of the Mountains and St. Bernard. At this time, the only thing set in stone are the dates for a final Mass at each church. The final Mass for St. Mary will be on Saturday, August 15, the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Virgin Mary, at approximately 9 AM. sbcf@volcano.net. If you are unable to use email, you can also call the parish office and they'll send your name and contact information on to the appropriate person in charge.

While we would like to have each Mass inside the church building, the number of attendees alongside the current Covid restrictions will determine where the Mass will take place, either inside or outside the church building.

As I mentioned last week, perhaps this time without congregational singing is an opportunity to discover more of the rich history of Church music, especially Gregorian chant and polyphony. You can find a lot on YouTube or Pandora. Pandora is what I have been using for Gregorian chant before Mass.

Keep in mind we do have Confession three times a week: Tuesdays from 5 to 5:45PM, Thursdays from 11:30 to 11:45AM, and Saturdays from 3:30 to 4:30PM.

Lastly, when a loved one passes, I often hear that while they were faithful and devout, they did not want a big to-do or they were too humble for much in terms of a Funeral Mass. As a result, they request no Funeral Mass. That is actually quite contrary to authentic Catholic practice. To plan appropriately for your passing is to include instructions for a Funeral Mass. The purpose of the Mass is to pray for the soul of the deceased. We proclaim and confess that those who die need our prayers and the Mass is the greatest prayer possible. To not have a funeral Mass is to deny prayers for the deceased that they very well need. Please keep that in mind if you are making your funeral arrangements in the near future. It never hurts to plan ahead. I already have mine arranged. :)

May God bless you this week!

Reminder

While our Bishop has continued to dispense us from the obligation to attend Mass, we are still obliged under divine law to sanctify the Lord's Day. This can be through praying the Rosary, reading and reflecting on the Sunday Mass readings, or watching and participating in Sunday Mass online/tv. If we fail to sanctify the Lord's Day with full knowledge and freely choosing to do so, that would be a grave matter that would need to be confessed before receiving Communion again.

Our parish was able to help provide basic necessities such as tables, chairs, bibles, laptop, chapel clothes, and benches. Sr. Nadia appeals to us once again. Dear Father Colin,

Greetings from Ethiopia.

I have shared with you about the essential need of making Grotto at CMRS [Conference of Major Religious

Superiors]. I cannot find the statue of our Lady in this country. Hence, I have asked my brother in Pakistan to give me the different prices of the statue of our Lady from Pakistan. The lowest price of the statue is 35000 Pakistani Rupee which corresponds to US Dollars 650.

Furthermore, I got the information from the constructor (Alexander) that how much it will cost to make Grotto. He told me that the things are very expensive. Therefore I need again 30,000 Ethiopian Birr which corresponds to US dollars 937.5

*The Grotto will be ready with a total amount in **1,587.5 US Dollars.***

Please I need your collaboration to fulfill my dream. I am sure your parishioners will contribute generously enough in this project. And our Lady will give us much more blessings than we need in our lives because we are working for other people.
