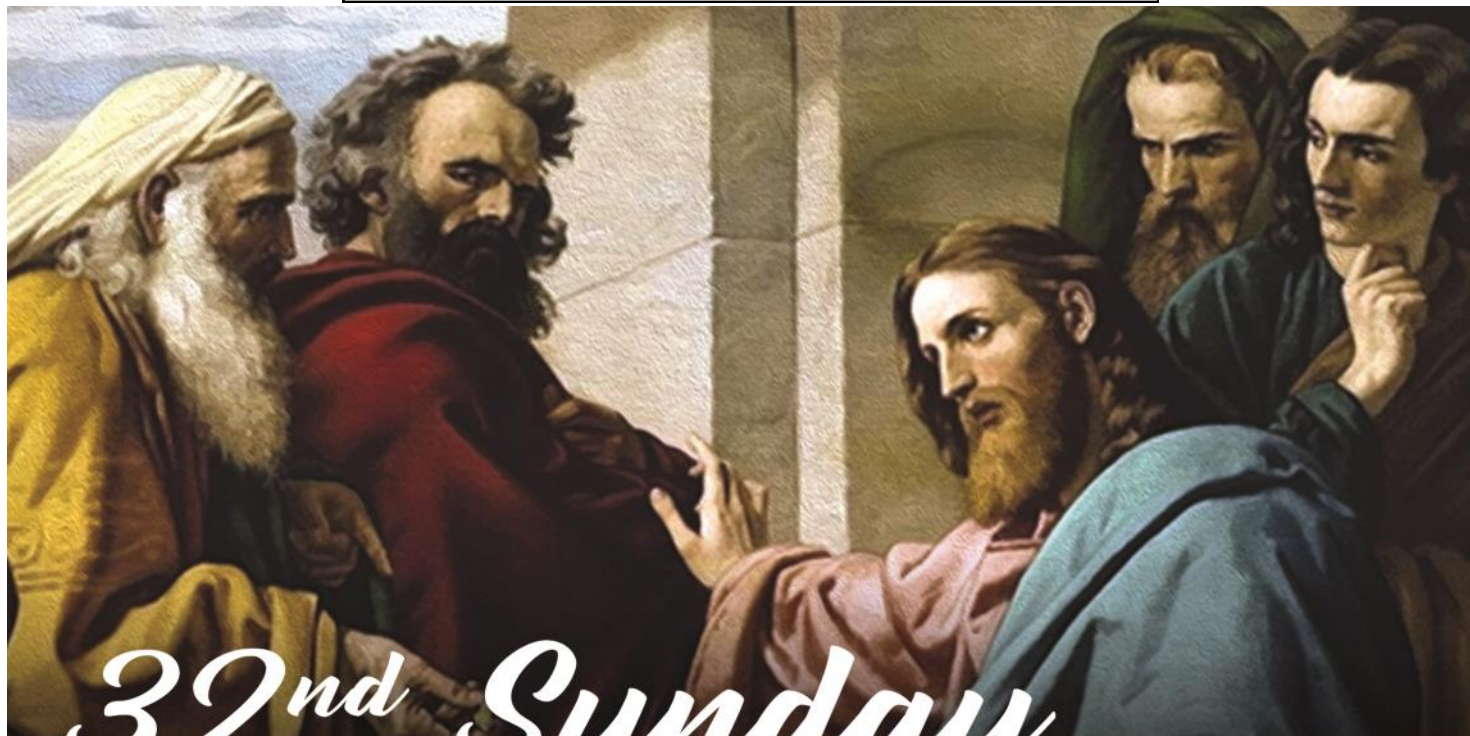

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Thanks again to everyone who helped with Trunk or Treat! We had about 16 trunks and lots of candy and many people coming through. Thankfully, the electricity was back on in time as well! I hope some of you were able to get out to the Our Lady of the Pines Annual Variety Show this weekend. The Sacred Heart Ladies Club has their spaghetti dinner this Saturday as well. We also have a nice group of parishioners planning our Christmas Brunch (Light the Way to Christmas Event). If anyone else is interested in helping out talk to Marge at the parish office.

As I previously mentioned, our Parish Leadership Team spent a few days in Anaheim for The Amazing Parish Conference. Three of the essential building blocks in their eyes are building a culture of teamwork, a culture of prayer and a culture of discipleship. How does that begin?

Well, it actually starts with our Parish Leadership Team beginning to live this well and then it flows into every other ministry and activity in the parish. So you will hopefully see many of the effects over this next year. I hope some of this culture change has already taken

place but there is much more in store in the months to come.

One of my main convictions coming away from this conference is that our staff is pretty amazing. Seriously. I enjoyed the time I was able to spend with them. And as well, if I might share another conviction, is that we all need to take more seriously our call to prayer and discipleship. I often like to recount what one priest confessor said to me when I shared about my prayer life - "A child could do that!" It was a call to action. Where is your prayer life? Let us stop making excuses and make our prayer life a priority.

One of those opportunities is coming up soon. We'll have our next extended Adoration time for Advent, December 3 to 4. Perhaps consider signing up for an hour or just drop in for a while. Our Parish Leadership Team has already planned more times for us to pray as a group for the parish. Another element is finding ways to live our discipleship. This means gathering with people, even family, to discuss our own faith lives and how the Lord is moving in our midst. I hope to offer more opportunities to make this call to discipleship more concrete as well.

We continue this week our reflection on the great treasure we have in the Liturgy. If you are interested in digging deeper, here are a couple of suggestions that might help your intellectual development on the topic:

Mass Confusion - *James Akin*

The How-To Book of the Mass - *Michael Dubruiel*

The Lamb's Supper - *Scott Hahn*

The Spirit of the Liturgy - *Joseph Ratzinger*

Lastly, we also come to the end of National Vocations Awareness Week. It is a week set aside to reflect on how each of us have a vocation, a calling from God, to a radical way of self-gift, including for some the call to priesthood or religious life. This is a good time to discuss with our children and grandchildren about how God has a plan for our lives and to watch a film or short clip on the priesthood or religious life as well. Let us pray that the Lord of the harvest may send us more workers!
