Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,
We have missed out on many things this Summer. One has been to give thanks for our graduating Seniors who have helped in different ministries. We are especially grateful to Diogo Pineda, Cade Clinkenbeard, Kenny Flynn, Mason Davie, and Michael Hayes for serving as Altar Servers these past years as well as to Raven Loffland for assisting as a Commentator. Let us pray that their participation in these ministries shapes the way they live their faith as adults.

As we draw close to the end of our Lawnchair Chats, I want to mention some of the things people have shared, especially in regards to their faith in this time of pandemic. I will do my best to summarize their thoughts:

This time has forced me to slow down and reflect a bit more on life. With less busyness, there was simply more time to be intentional about living day to day.

Being denied the opportunity to receive the Eucharist was good because it led me to greater love for this sacrament. But as well it forced me to grow other

elements of my spiritual life as I realized the poverty I had without the Eucharist.

I found this time has made me less selfish and focused on my own needs as I have spent more time praying for others.

I have missed the community life and it has led me to calling people, especially my own family.

I have been more open about my faith, especially sharing with people about going to Mass on Sundays or letting them know I am praying for them.

We have prayed the rosary more often as a family.

I also want to share a few words from Msgr. Pope who mentions two unhealthy results of this pandemic:

"My pastoral concern is that we as a nation and as a Church have succumbed to excessive fear, which bespeaks a spiritual problem. The medical concerns arising from the pandemic are not without merit, but they are not unprecedented. What is unique today is the col-

lective paralysis brought on by this fear. I write to express my concern and to reiterate the constant biblical cry, 'Do not be afraid!.'

"Now so many are cowering in fear. They view every human being they encounter as a potential source of grave illness or even death: 'He looks healthy, but I'd better stay far away because he may be carrying COVID-19!' Never mind a calculation of relative risks; every human contact might pose an existential threat."

Let us move from fear to faith and while we remain physically distant, see each other with love of Christ.
