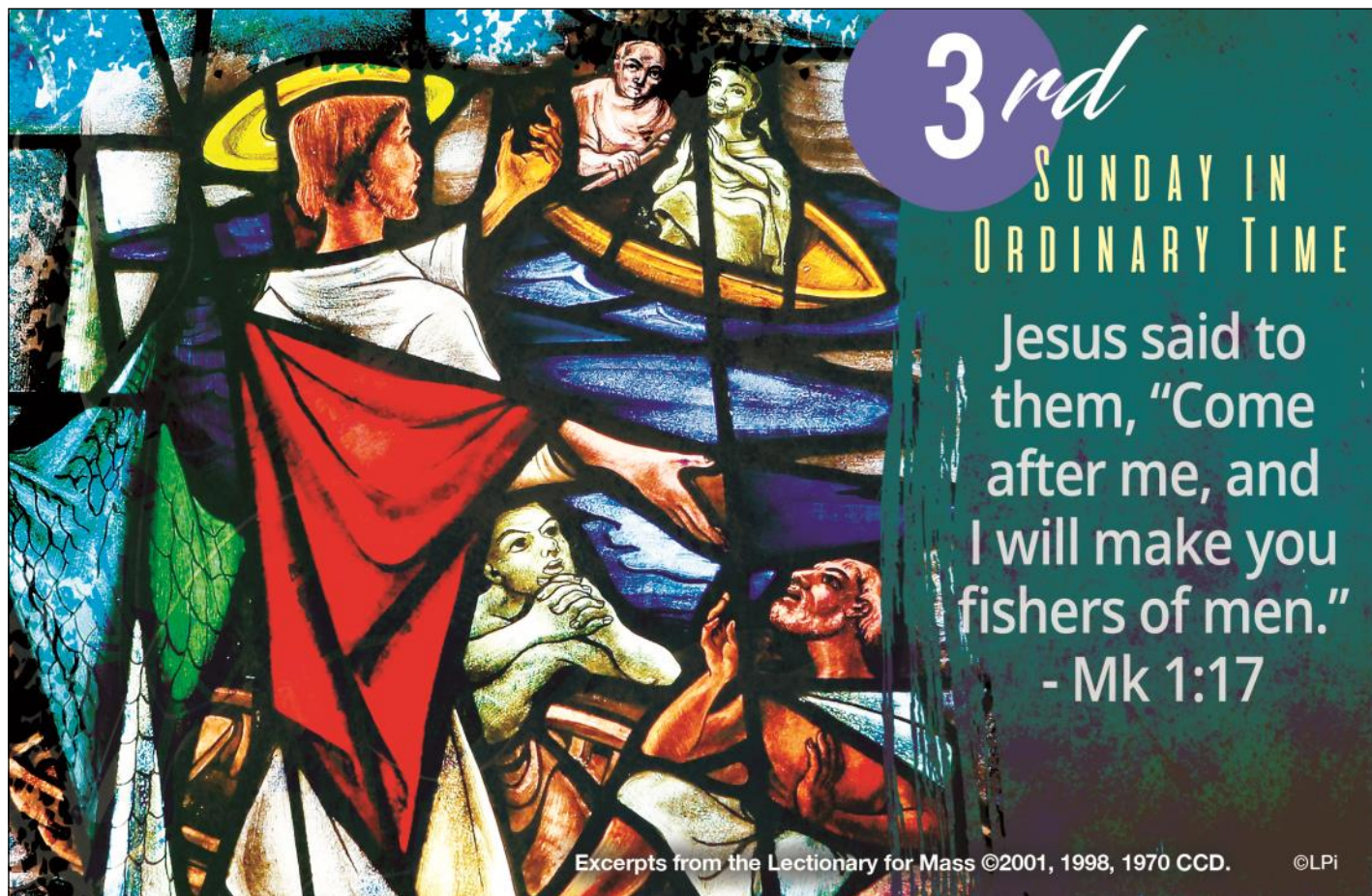

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Thank you for your support of Sr. Nadia's work in Ethiopia. As you may know, there is the beginnings of a civil war going on in the north of the country. She is in Addis Ababa, the capitol, but not completely removed from the violence. Our donations to her work have helped them to purchase tables, chairs, and other liturgical items as well as a new photocopier after their last one was damaged. We also donated money for them to build a marian grotto and as construction has begun on it, we will share pictures soon. Thank you for your ongoing support and please keep her and her ministry and the people of Ethiopia in your prayers.

Our next Tag Sale is coming up in March. We are taking donations as of the beginning of February. You can certainly start preparing items to donate. This year the majority of the funds raised will go to cover the cost of the repainting of St. Patrick's Rectory and the Bell Tower. Both have been in need of repair for a while. The repainting includes stripping down and scraping off loose paint, filling and sanding, caulking and then ultimately repainting. This is a laborious project due to the age of the buildings and the heights of them as well. While the Tag

Sale will help to cover the costs, the repainting will most likely exceed the expected amount raised. If you would like to donate to this specific project, reach out to Liz or Marge in the Parish Office.

I hope you are enjoying the work of Spiritual Adoption. I must tell you that I really have enjoyed offering a Mass each week for this intention alongside our weekly litany of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. Plus parishioners have been sharing with me their conversations and how they are encouraging people in their faith. My Spiritual Adoptee list has grown over these last weeks as the Lord has placed more people on my heart to pray and fast for. I pray that it is fruitful for you as well. If you need help or ideas please let me know and let us carry on knowing that God can do all things for those who have faith.

I will be away this week, from Monday January 25 to the morning of Wednesday January 27. There will not be Mass at 7am on Monday, 6pm on Tuesday or 7am on Wednesday. My plan is to return in time for Mass at OLOP at 1130am on Wednesday. Each year the Diocese provides a few "Christmas days" for the priest. So these are a couple days away to recoup the lost energy. I always find even a few days off from the normal routine provides a

moment of reflection and renewed energy towards the work ahead.

We pray as well for our nation with the inauguration of President Biden. While our country has become more secular as the years go by, it is good to see prayer at the heart of this transition. Let us join our prayers with everyone praying for renewal of hearts and renewed respect for each human person and the inalienable rights and responsibilities we have as members of this great nation.

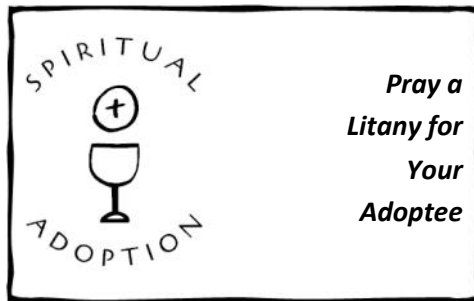
