Dear Friends in Christ

I am going to give you a challenge. It is one that will last the whole year. So be careful before taking me up on it! That being said, I do think we can all handle it and as Catholics, it is part of what it means to be a disciple. So here goes.

I want you to spend the next couple months reflecting on and discerning one person in your life that God wants you to invite into the Church or back to the Church. If not, we can match you up with a group. Just call the parish office. Part of the power of the 3 Conversations is becoming comfortable sharing a bit more about your own faith journey and how God's grace has moved in your life.

Perhaps find out why they drifted from the Church or why they have never gone in the first place. If you have any questions, let me know. But please consider spending this time asking the Lord for guidance so that you might see who He has placed in your life to lead them back to His mercy. Our patron for this journey will be St. Monica, who spent many years in prayer and fasting for her son St. Augustine.

This is also the Month of the Rosary alongside Respect Life Month. Consider making a commitment to praying the Rosary each day this month or every Sunday as a family.


