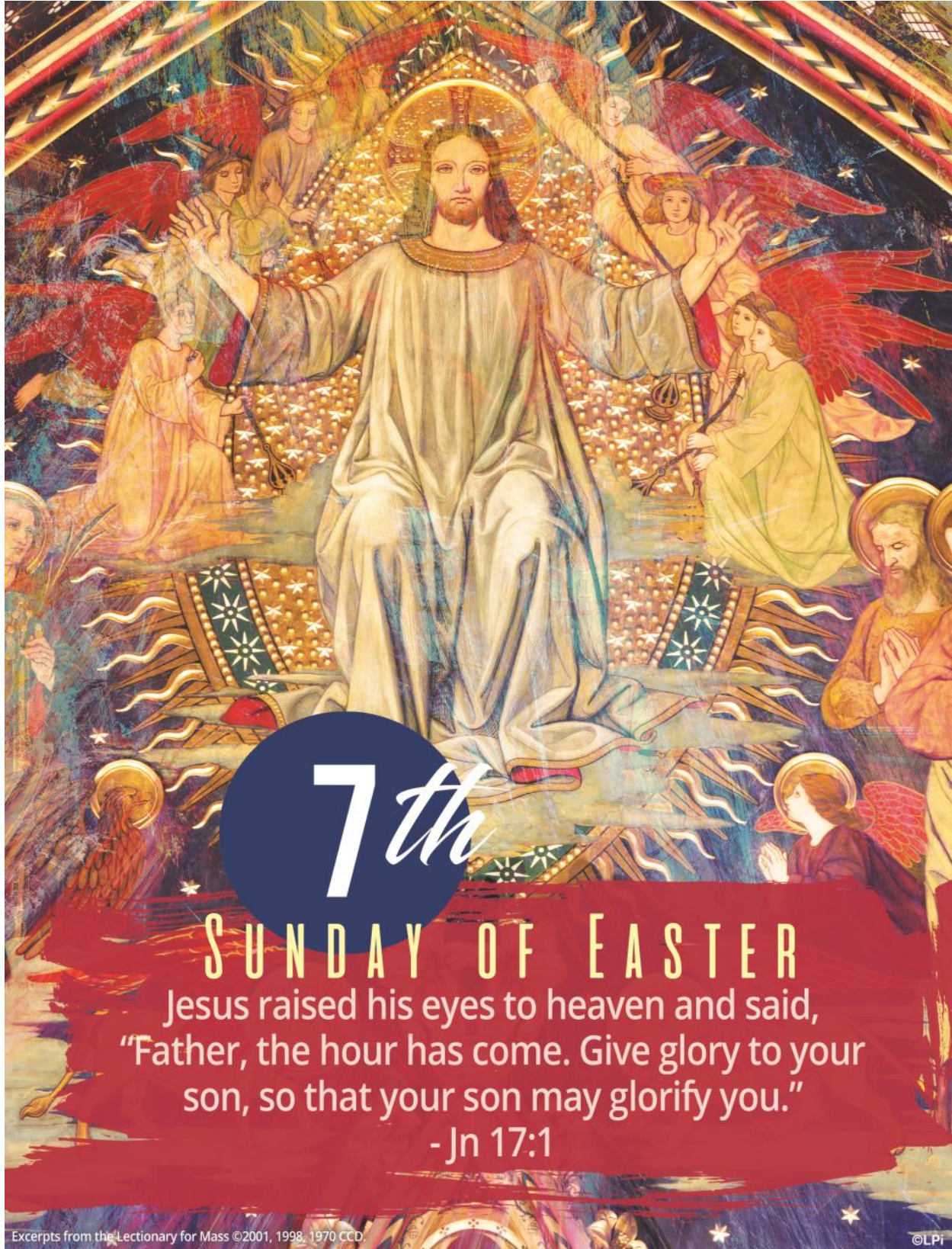

Dear Friends in Christ,
As states and churches slowly begin to reopen, the constant question on our minds is when that will happen for us. While we are certainly preparing for a reopening soon, there is not a set date. When there is I will certainly let you know right away and explain the procedures we will have in place. In the meantime we carry on in this strange time of lingering, in a limbo of sorts, awaiting the day. I did receive some more information from our Bishop Jaime Soto on what a reopening will involve, including the need to provide for proper social distancing, removing hymnals, and the like. Our parish staff is currently working with me on what that will entail and we will eventually be looking for volunteers who are very faithful but also often fall into the bracket designated as more vulnerable by the CDC, we will be needing younger volunteers to help out. So please keep this in mind for the coming future.
Just so you know, we do regularly sanitize the church pews and doors and

bathrooms so you are able to come to the church in the afternoon and pray before the Blessed Sacrament. And as well, we continue to regularly offer Confession on Tuesday, Saturday and Sunday.

That said, this time is a period of transition for many of our young people who are graduating from high school or being promoted from junior high. Let us keep them all in our prayers as the celebrations are more muted and our capacity for gathering is limited. It makes it more difficult to mourn the passing of time and embrace what is to come. In a week or so we'll have a little tribute to our graduating seniors on our SKD Video Update.

This is also the time when priests are being moved. Three out of the four priests I consider very good friends are all moving. So please pray for all these transitions! But don't worry, as far as I know, I'm not going anywhere. Also, a seminarian who visited us some time back, Deacon Ryan Mahar, is being ordained a priest on Saturday, June 6,

for our Diocese. Sadly, no more than ten people can gather for this great moment. It is heartbreaking in many ways. One of my greatest joys in my life was gathering with all the people I had met throughout my life on the road to the priesthood. If I was not biting my tongue throughout the whole Ordination Mass I would have wept. But truly in these moments of great poverty, both material and spiritual, the Lord enriches us more plentifully with His grace. It is something my own brother, and I know many others, are having to face as their wedding plans are being changed almost daily.

Lastly, as I mentioned last Sunday, this concept of family culture is a great point of discussion for each of you. Perhaps talk about it at the dinner table and what you consider to be part of your family culture and perhaps what you want to add or remove from it as well.

What To Do on the Lord's Day

Those who will not attend Sunday Mass should prayerfully unite themselves to the Lord through other appropriate means. Below are three ways:

1. Reflect on the Sunday Mass readings, which you can find on the website of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, usccb.org/readings. *Magnificat* has also made their online version free to access. It includes the readings, reflections, and prayers in this Lenten season, <https://us.magnificat.net/free>.

2. Watch live coverage of the Holy Mass. For those with access to the Eternal Word Television Network (EWTN), you can watch live daily Masses through their TV channel. We

also stream our Sunday 9:30 AM Mass at SKD on our Facebook page, facebook.com/stkatharinedrexelamador, as well as 1340 AM and 96.5 FM. You may also listen to the Sunday homilies, which are available at soundcloud.com/frcolinwen or our parish website, www.stkatharinedrexel.com.

3. Most importantly, all Catholics unable to attend Mass should make a spiritual communion. If you cannot receive the Blessed Sacrament at Mass, the ardent desire to receive Jesus in the Sacrament allows you to partake in its effects. In other words, although you do not receive the Eucharist physically, you can still receive the graces that flow from the Eucharist. Although we obtain

more graces when we eat His Body and drink His Blood as He commanded, a spiritual communion still produces a partial participation in the effects of the Sacrament. Here is a brief *Act of Spiritual Communion* which you can learn and then pray whenever unable to receive the Eucharist:

My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.

Month of May Dedicated to Mary

The month of May is dedicated to the Blessed Mother, Mary. This is a wonderful opportunity to set aside a little time each day to pray the Rosary. If you are able to only pray one decade of the Rosary, take the time to do so. The gentle repetition of the words helps us to enter into the silence of our hearts, where Christ's spirit dwells. The prayer, *Hail Holy Queen*, is prayed at the end of the recitation of the five decades of the Rosary.

When possible, consider praying the Rosary with others.
