Dear Friends in Christ,

Today on this 3rd Sunday in Ordinary time the Church invites us to reflect on the treasure and gift that is the Word of God. While we are not people of the book, that is to say only of the Scriptures, the Word of God is proclaimed in a rich and beautiful way through the Scriptures. So if we want to encounter the Word of God we must not only experience Him in the words proclaimed at Mass and His Incarnate Word in the Eucharist, but let the Word permeate our lives by regular reading. Here are some suggestions on how you can do that:

1. Get a subscription to a monthly missal that includes all the readings for Mass throughout the week, including on Sunday. I highly recommend the Magnificat as the best among them. Not only it is a nice layout, they bring in rich and profound readings from the Church Fathers, Saints, and some contemporary authors.



2. You can also get the actual Daily Roman Missal that includes every

reading in the 3 year cycle along with all the prayers the priest says at Mass. It is a nice way to follow along throughout the year. This is the old school approach. And it does take a while to learn how to use it. But it is a great benefit.



3. Or dust off your bible and make a habit of reading it daily. The Gospels are always a good place to start. Or consider praying one of the Psalms each day. If you don't have a bible, which translation should you buy? There are a number of Catholic translations out there so you can choose. The NAB is the closest to what we hear at Mass. But the NRSV Catholic Edition is another great choice as well. The English Standard Version Catholic Edition is one the newest and is receiving very good reviews. You may ask why some of these translations say "Catholic Edition". Some translations are done in cooperation between the Catholic and Protestant world. Any bible that has the imprimatur (authorization to publish on behalf of a Catholic Bishop) is fine for use. I would not recommend using a non-Catholic Christian bible. Not only

are they generally missing 7 books from the Old Testament and parts of Daniel and Esther, the translations vary vastly in quality.

4. Get a Catholic app like iBreviary. This app allows you to read the daily readings as well as pray the Liturgy of the Hours. The Liturgy of the Hours is a great way to delve into Scripture as well because you pray with the psalms and other passages of Scripture.



Whatever you do, find a way to dive into the Word of God so that you might encounter Him more deeply. And perhaps imagine, reading the Word of God in the Scriptures while being in the presence of the Incarnate Word of God in the Church! That's perhaps an even more powerful way to encounter the Lord.
