Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Christmas season continues as we celebrate the Feast of the Epiphany, the manifestation of Christ to the Gentiles. This moment in our salvation history reminds us that Christ is for all people everywhere and the true source of life.

One of my great joys during my seminary studies was to do part of my formation in Rome at the Pontifical North American College. It is where I experienced the Church as universal and studied with men and women, priests and religious, from China, Nigeria, Malawi, Egypt, Korea, Panama, Mexico, India, Sweden and even Pakistan. Some had to sneak out of their country to come and study with us in Rome.

I still keep in touch with some of my classmates. One is Sr. Nadia Lazrus. We're actually about the same age and started formation at the same time. She is a

religious from Pakistan and belongs to

Sisters of Charity of St. Jeanne-Antide Thouret. While Pakistan is a majority Muslim country, her family is Catholic and devout in their faith. Her brother is a priest. The Church in Pakistan faces much persecution (their churches have been attacked and bombed), but they continue on. The Sisters of Charity have sent Sr. Nadia to Ethiopia to work among the

there. As Sr. Nadia struggles under the weight of very poor conditions she asked if I knew anyone who might be willing to support her work, even in a small way. She is working with the Conference of Major Religious Superiors to provide an institute that gives religious formation, computer skills, and instruction in the English language. She has shared that they are in need of some chairs and tables, two laptops and printers, bibles, and some of

the essentials to celebrate Holy Mass. While we, as a parish, do collections for different efforts and do not always see the direct fruit of our offerings, this is an opportunity to see our charitable impact up close. If you would like to support her work, even with a very small donation, you can send it to the office marked in an envelope for "Sr. Nadia".

This month of January portends to be a busy one as well. Our Women's Day of Recollection is just a week away. I encourage you to join us. Our speaker is Mercedes Hollcraft. She's been involved in many different ministries in the life of the Church and is Principal at St. Stanislaus Catholic School in Modesto. The following Saturday is our Men's Day of Recollection with John Johnson as he speaks on reclaiming spiritual headship through the Father's heart and rediscovering authentic masculine identity. The last Saturday of January is the Annual Walk for Life West Coast in San Francisco. If you have not grabbed a seat on the bus, there may still be a couple left as of this writing.

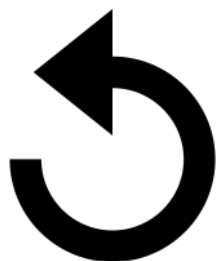

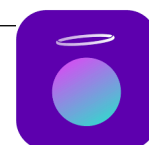
