

Dear Friends in Christ,

As we celebrate our Independence Day as a nation, we are reminded of the great sacrifices that those who have gone before us have made so that we might live in peace and prosperity. But no nation remains great if those who follow are not willing to make similar sacrifices so that the foundations upon which our nation stands remain strong. So let us pray for our nation and those who lead us through elected office, that their hearts might be conformed to the will of God and we the citizens might be virtuous in exercising the freedoms for which many sacrificed and died.

Now for some more news. Our Choir Director at the 930AM and now 10AM Mass at SKD, Gerry Rheault, let me know last week that he had one of those good news/bad news scenarios. The good news is that he was offered the position of Parish Choir Director at Divine Savior in Orangevale and has decided to accept the position. As a result, he is resigning as the Choir Director for the 10AM Mass here. Our loss is certainly their gain. We thank him for all his generous service to

the parish in these last years. Kim LaSavio has generously stepped up and will be taking his place providing music for the 10AM at this time.

As well, I need to share with you some difficult news. Before I share that I do want to say that I do love you guys. I love this parish. I love being here. I love the relationships I've formed with so many of you and I hope you realize my one concern is to bring you to a living relationship with Jesus Christ. That's the heart of it. I've been with many of you for a baptism of a new baby. I've celebrated over 1200 Masses with you, including for our first communicants. I've run to Sutter Amador more times than I can count to anoint one of our loved parishioners who was dving. I've celebrated burials and funerals and mourned with you the death of loved ones, prayed for healing with the sick, presided over marriages, and attended the parties that have followed. I hope you realize I do love you. Second, I am sorry. Sorry that I have at times not always done my best or been my best. We can expect the priest to only have good days but even I

have bad days and I am sorry if my words or actions have ever offended you.

That being said, sometime back I approached our Bishop Jaime Soto about closing a couple of the mission churches. At the time I also spoke with our parish staff, the Finance Council and the Pastoral Council. With the support of the Bishop and parish leadership, I want to inform you, with certain sadness, that we are going to close St. Mary of the Mountains and St. Bernard. This decision is not being taken lightly. No priest wants to have to close churches. Rather we want to see them open and filled with the faithful. But we also have to be realistic about how the parish will continue to remain a source of evangelical strength with limited resources and with an aging community. Most of us probably knew this when they started talking about parish mergers many years ago, even if we did not feel like we were told the full truth. To be honest, when I first came here my hope was that we could, as much as possible, maintain it as is.
