

Dear Friends in Christ,

The Church has once again been in the news for a couple things so I wanted to share with you some thoughts. First, the Associated Press put out a story on how the Church has been able to make use of the Paycheck Protection Program. The piece was quite biased in its presentation. Here is the response from the USCCB:

"The Catholic Church is the largest nongovernmental supplier of social services in the United States. Each year, our parishes, and pray this was an accident. Sadly, we schools and ministries serve millions of people in need, regardless of race, ethnicity or religion. The novel coronavirus only intensified the needs of the people we serve and the demand for our ministries. The loans we applied for enabled our essential ministries to continue to function in a time of national emergency.

"The Paycheck Protection Program was designed to protect the jobs of Americans from all walks of life, regardless of whether they work for for-profit or non-profit employers, faith-based or secular."

As well, the U.S. Supreme Court thankfully ruled in favor of Catholic schools and the Little Sisters of the Poor in two important cases. In the case of Catholic schools, it was a question over whether Catholic schools were able to hire and fire teachers according to their own principles and

values. In the case of the Little Sisters of the Poor, it was a matter of providing health insurance that did not participate in anything morally objectionable, like artificial contraception. These too are being portrayed in much of mainstream media as a step backwards. But these are rulings in favor of religious freedom, an essential principle upon which our nation is built.

Also, you may have heard of the burning of St. Gabriel Mission. We can only hope are starting to hear of other violent acts against churches across the country. Let us pray for peace in the hearts of all and respect for places of worship.



Lastly, many have asked about my brother's wedding. It was a nice and simple affair. I do want to mention a little about them both. I met Crystal while I was in the May God bless you! seminary. She was a Junior in high school helping as a bible study leader for a high school youth ministry. After graduation, she attended UC Berkeley and was very

much involved in the Newman Center. She invited me to speak at one of their Newman nights. She was also active in starting the University of California Catholic Conferences that are held each year at different public universities in California, as well as, in an annual Chinese Catholic Conference. She was, and still is, involved in a Catholic medical missionary organization, See the Lord, and was helping to coordinate young adult ministry at St. Raymond's in Menlo Park. My brother, Matthew, eventually was a bible study leader in the same group as Crystal. He studied at UCSD and was involved in leadership in a Catholic fellowship there. After graduation he was teaching Confirmation classes at a local parish and working on a youth ministry program. When Matthew returned to NorCal, he worked with Crystal in the young adult community. I mention this because they are good reminders of the importance of the lay apostolate and how important it is that we engage our people, both young and old, to see how they are called to serve Christ and others. I would share my own involvement over the years but I think I have boasted enough for one bulletin. Pray for my humility!


