

Dear Friends in Christ,

I am extremely grateful for the work we are doing as a parish. Our good works were highlighted this past month when 12 of our parishioners, young and old, spoke on how they are living out their own discipleship and stewardship daily. Perhaps this has stirred something in your own heart as well! The sign that our parish is alive is the fruit we see in hearts moving towards discipleship and real commitment to following Jesus Christ.

As we enter this month of October, which is dedicated to the Rosary, I encourage you to consider how to make Mary a more integral part of your prayer. It seems that in October there tends to be a rise in curiosity about death and the occult. What better time to invoke the intercession of Mary! It is also a good practice to pray the prayer to St. Michael the Archangel.

In November we will start a Marian Consecration as a parish. If you have never done it before I encourage you to consider doing it, on your own, or as a family. It involves 33 days of prayer leading up to a day where we all consecrate ourselves as well as the parish to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. It is a way of deepening our love for Mary and growing, with her, into greater intimacy

with our Lord. The prayer and reflection each day is short and the idea is to carry the reflection you read with you throughout the day. Reflection books are \$5.00 and can be reserved after Mass or by calling the parish office. We will start on November 5th and continue in prayer until the Feast of the Immaculate Conception on December 8th.

I will once again be offering a day of spiritual direction on Thursday, Oct. 24. This is an opportunity to reflect on your own relationship with the Lord and how He wants to draw you closer to his Sacred Heart. But that is not all! Fr. Jesus Hernandez will also be helping from 9AM -12PM that day. If you would prefer to meet with him you can also sign up for that. He is a good and holy priest with all kinds of good wisdom. He is also available to hear your confession as well.

There are some other upcoming events for October to keep on the calendar. Our Youth Ministry is having a car wash on Sunday October 13 to raise funds to go to a weeklong Catholic Summer Camp in SoCal. The Knights of Columbus have a gigantic Yard Sale the last weekend in October. On Thursday October 31st we will have a Vigil Mass for All Saints Day (Holy Day of Obligation) followed by our first annual Trunk or Treat. We do need volunteer trunks if you would like to

bring your car and decorate the trunk and give out candy as kids come around. You can talk to Dan for more information on this.

Lastly, I will be away this week with my fellow priests of the Diocese of Sacramento for our priest convocation. This happens once every four years or so. The convocation takes the place of our annual priest study days, and gives us a chance to reflect on the state of the diocese and presbyterate and how to move forward as followers and pastors in the service of Christ. Please keep us in prayer for the week. There will still be Mass Monday and Friday morning at SKD but not from Tuesday-Thursday.

May God bless you this week!
