Dear Friends,

This week we began registration for Faith Formation classes for the upcoming year. It may seem hard to imagine but classes are coming to a close this month even as we await the days for our First Communion and Confirmation celebrations. Please pass the word to friends and family as often times people who have been away for a while do want to make a return for sacramental preparation.

As well, we are slowly receiving catechumens and candidates into the Church in small groups of less than ten people. While it does not come with the same festivity as we usually expect, there is a great joy to see people come into full communion with the Church and experience the sacramental life. We will start classes again in the Fall for those interested in becoming Catholic. Once again, please pass the word. Often times there are people around us who simply need an invitation to consider the beauty of our Catholic faith.

Today we also celebrate Mother's Day. While it is not part of our liturgical calendar, it provides us the opportunity to thank the Lord for the blessing of all the women in our lives, who live out

their vocation as mothers both biological and spiritual. This can also be a difficult day for many who have lost their own mothers, who are unable to have children, or who have lost a child. We give thanks, therefore, for all women and the gift they are to us. Here is a beautiful prayer to offer today:

*Lord, today we thank you for our mothers: the ones who gave us life, the ones who chose us through adoption, and the unofficial mothers who were a strong and compassionate presence in our lives when our biological mothers weren't up to the task. We pray for all those who have lost a child or have been unable to conceive.*

*We remember the selfless love with which they cared for us when we were most vulnerable, the tears they dried and fears they soothed when we were troubled, the encouragement they offered when we had little faith in our own abilities, the guidance they provided when we felt lost, the lost sleep and worries they endured when we were sick or simply growing up, the strength it took to hold us close, yet let us fly.*

*Not all our mothers lived up to the ideal of parenthood either due to bad choices or circumstances beyond their control. Today we pray for them as well.*

*Touch them with your healing grace and wisdom. And if we carry in our hearts any lingering bitterness or resentment about their shortcomings, touch us with your grace and wisdom too so that we can move forward toward a brighter future instead of remaining stuck in a dark past.*

*We pray that our mothers who are no longer with us are embraced by Your love in the next life.*

*We pray that future mothers, expectant mothers and new mothers experience the joys that come from putting a child's needs ahead of their own, even when the sacrifices seem challenging.*

*We pray that our mothers who are still living experience Your enduring and ever-present love through the appreciation and gratitude that we, their children, show them not just this Mother's Day, but throughout the year.*

*In union with Mary, our spiritual mother to whom we can always turn for help and guidance, we ask your generous blessings. Amen.*

## What To Do on the Lord's Day

Those who will not attend Sunday Mass should prayerfully unite themselves to the Lord through other appropriate means. Below are three ways:

**1. Reflect on the Sunday Mass readings**, which you can find on the website of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, [usccb.org/readings](https://usccb.org/readings). *Magnificat* has also made their online version free to access. It includes the readings, reflections, and prayers in this Lenten season, <https://us.magnificat.net/free>.

**2. Watch live coverage of the Holy Mass.** For those with access to the Eternal Word Television Network (EWTN), you can watch live daily Masses through their TV channel. We

also stream our Sunday 9:30 AM Mass at SKD on our Facebook page, [facebook.com/stkatharinedrexelamador](https://facebook.com/stkatharinedrexelamador), as well as 1340 AM and 96.5 FM. You may also listen to the Sunday homilies, which are available at [soundcloud.com/frcolinwen](https://soundcloud.com/frcolinwen) or our parish website, [www.stkatharinedrexel.com](http://www.stkatharinedrexel.com).

**3. Most importantly**, all Catholics unable to attend Mass should make a spiritual communion. If you cannot receive the Blessed Sacrament at Mass, the ardent desire to receive Jesus in the Sacrament allows you to partake in its effects. In other words, although you do not receive the Eucharist physically, you can still receive the graces that flow from the Eucharist. Although we obtain

more graces when we eat His Body and drink His Blood as He commanded, a spiritual communion still produces a partial participation in the effects of the Sacrament. Here is a brief *Act of Spiritual Communion* which you can learn and then pray whenever unable to receive the Eucharist:

***My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.***

## Month of May Dedicated to Mary

The month of May is dedicated to the Blessed Mother, Mary. This is a wonderful opportunity to set aside a little time each day to pray the Rosary. If you are able to only pray one decade of the Rosary, take the time to do so. The gentle repetition of the words helps us to enter into the silence of our hearts, where Christ's spirit dwells. The prayer, *Hail Holy Queen*, is prayed at the end of the recitation of the five decades of the Rosary.

When possible, consider praying the Rosary with others.
