

Dear Friends in Christ,

Thank you for all your support of the Summer Tag Sale. Thanks especially to Elise, Mary and all the many volunteers both young and old who helped out! It raised over \$12,000 in support of the work of the parish. Of those funds received, \$1,500 is going to St. Vincent de Paul Society as they begin to ramp up their charitable works after this stay at home period. As we were not able to have the Rummage Sale at Our Lady of the Pines, many of our parishioners from upcountry came to help the Tag Sale at SKD. So \$1,500 is also going to the OLOP Society. The rest of the funds are being dedicated to the work of renovating the front of the Parish Center.

Some months back I reached out to a local architectural design firm to see how we could make the Parish Center more of a Catholic space. The design phase is getting close to completion and the architectural work is going to begin soon. The funds raised from our sale more than covered the design costs so the rest of the funds will be dedicated towards the architectural work. I have worked with a number of parishioners as well as the Pastoral Council, Finance Council, and Parish Staff to come up with something truly beautiful. Now the obvious questions include what will this

design look like, when will it take place, and how much will it cost. I would just encourage patience. In the weeks to come, I will unveil the designs for you to see. We do not currently have a timeline or a cost estimate. This might be a project that is done in phases.

There has also been more discussion about the possibility of a parish school. For many of you who had Catholic schooling, we often think of the typical design of a school campus with nine or more classrooms, one for each grade, and 30 or so kids filtering in and out. We are not quite looking for that model, considering the landscape of our county. We are looking at the possibility of a microschool, which could grow slowly over time. This would mean we could start with 20-30 kids with shared classroom space. One curriculum that makes that very feasible is the Montessori method. So while we are still very much at the tentative planning stages, we are looking at the feasibility of such a project and what it will take to get it going. Anyone with interest in this or supporting this project can reach out to Alicia Forberg. Her number is 209-712-6601.

Also, you may have heard of the recent tearing down of the statue of St. Junipero Serra in San Francisco. Archbishop Cordileone shared some

thoughts on this:

"What is happening to our society? A renewed national movement to heal memories and correct the injustices of racism and police brutality in our country has been hijacked by some into a movement of violence, looting and vandalism. The toppling and defacing of statues in Golden Gate Park, including that of St. Junipero Serra, have become the latest example. The memorialization of historic figures merits an honest and fair discussion as to how and to whom such honor should be given. But here, there was no such rational discussion; it was mob rule, a troubling phenomenon that seems to be repeating itself throughout the country."

I would encourage you to read the rest of his statement, as he points out why St. Junipero Serra was made a saint and the great love he had for the indigenous peoples of America. We are at a time of great chaos and judgment, reminiscent of the French Revolution, where we seem to be constantly searching out the next collaborator who needs to lose his head. Let us pray for the descent of the Holy Spirit upon our country and culture that the Lord may renew what has been broken.


