

Dear Friends in Christ,

I was supremely impressed to see so many parishioners gathered together for a meeting we had to see how we could help support Fr. Relihan in his desire to continue living at Sacred Heart rectory. It is a testament to his own priestly ministry and the way in which he has led people closer to Christ and as well the love that many of you have for him. Let us pray for his continued good health and peace of heart.

Last week a couple people shared with me their own encounters with the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist so I wanted to share them with you. The first mentioned how she had fallen away from the faith for 33 years. During that time, she became involved in a Protestant faith community and was trained to reject anything Catholic. But eventually her devout Catholic mom needed fulltime care and she moved to take care of her. Her mom would pray the rosary and invite her to join in but she would pray on her own. But she would take her mom to Mass and while her mom received Communion, she would just come forward for a blessing.

One Sunday, as she came forward for her blessing, Jesus spoke into her heart and said "I am here in the Eucharist". It was a pivotal moment in her life and it led her back to the Catholic Church.

The other was someone who while raised Catholic, started going to a nondenominational Christian service in college. One Sunday they passed around their version of communion with a packet of bread and grape juice. She looked at it and realized this simply was not what Jesus meant to give us. The next Sunday she was back to Mass and she never went back to that service.

The Lord does speak. These stories are not rare. Even as we wander, the Lord calls for we are made for Him, to receive Him, and He is truly present in the Eucharist, Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity.

As I mentioned, there are three more principles of this modern vision of the world to mention.

The fourth is one I mentioned in my homily last week, the intoxication with time and space. The fifth is a distorted understanding of freedom, a freedom

with no specific goal or aim in mind. Rather freedom to do what you want rather than freedom to do what you ought. As a result, God becomes the true enemy of freedom as He appears as the one who imposes apparently arbitrary rules that limit our freedom. The sixth is we reduce ourselves down to consumer experience. As we realize we cannot perfect the world and that all of our dreams for a better world fail, we simply reduce ourselves to focus on entertainment and distraction to keep our minds at ease. Talk about a low ceiling world we live in!

Lastly, please pray for our Faith Formation families and those who begin on the road to entrance into the life of the Church this week. This is some of the most important work we do as a parish.

May God bless you this week!
