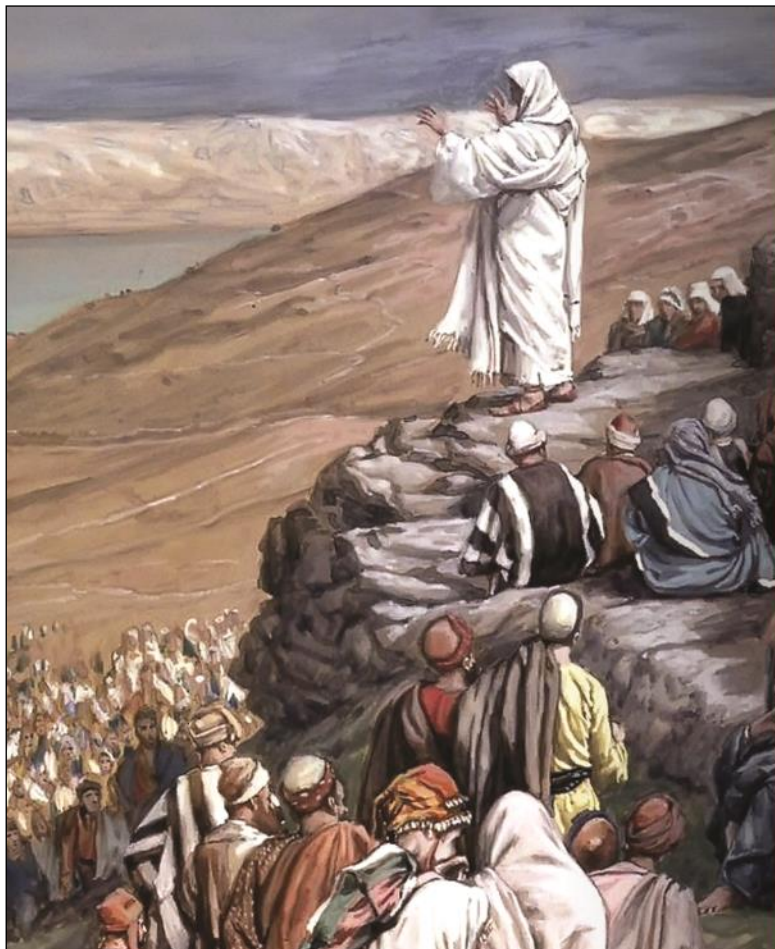

Dear Disciples of the Lord,

Today we begin our short homily series on stewardship. Perhaps a good image of this is if we suppose we had a pet guinea pig. We provide everything for that guinea, food, water, shelter, medicine, and all the rest, including loving kindness. What can the guinea do in return? Well at a material level, the return is kind of weak. The guinea won't make money for us or provide us with any tangible product. Unless perhaps it has a modeling career that takes off. But that guinea gives what it has. It gives its love and perhaps just by being cute. Jesus often compares us to sheep (not exactly the greatest of compliments) but perhaps we can also be considered as guineas. We do not have much to give for all that the Lord has given but from what we do have, we are called to give generously.

With stewardship it is best to start with the hard stuff first, money. This can be an uncomfortable area of discussion as we ask what use does God have for our money and why does the Church need it? As we know from analyzing the early Church reality, the Church does not need money. The early Church had 12 bishops, no priests or deacons, a few hundred laity, no buildings or churches or seminaries, and it thrived. Yet we also know that as the Church grew, so did its institutional footprint, and the support needed to make it work. In the bul-

letin this weekend you can see our financial report and how we have made use of your financial gifts given in support of the mission of the parish. It also details all the work being done by so many volunteers and staff to extend the Kingdom of God. I hope it inspires you to see that your treasure given generously is going to good use and is bearing fruit.

But we do not primarily give financially to support the institutional footprint. Rather, to give financially or tithing is an act of worship. We see this in the offering of sacrifice by Abel. Cain's offering is rejected because it is half-hearted. Abel offers to God his first fruits. As well, Noah offered a sacrifice after the end of the great flood. Abraham offered as well when he won a great victory over his enemies. Giving is an act of worship. As well, Jesus often in Scripture warns about the power that money can have over the human heart. The proper response to this is to give freely and generously so that money might not have any mastery over us. As we give freely we gain treasure in heaven for our hearts are set free to love the Lord with all our hearts. All this is also a further reminder that we are stewards of our money and not its owners. We must discern wisely how best to make use of the gifts God has given for His Glory and for the salvation of our souls.

I greatly appreciate how so many of you

are so generous with your time, talent and financial gifts. I pray that this ongoing reflection invites us into conversation with Christ and that He might make us truly generous in our gifts.

This Sunday is also our Ministry Fair at the 10am Mass. The goal is to provide you with an opportunity to see some of the many ministries in our parish. More are listed on our parish commitment card and more opportunities are out there. If you are not sure how you might be called to serve, reach out to Liz at the Parish Office and she can give you some direction.

Thank you to all who joined us for our 40 Hours Devotion. It is a rich and blessed tradition of the Church. I never grew up with it myself but often heard about it in my own seminary formation. It is powerful Eucharistic devotion and reminds us that the faith will never be cool or "with it". Honestly, what is cool about rising in the middle of the night deprived of sleep so as to pray? But we do it because the Lord is truly present in the Eucharist and to spend that time with Him is life changing. It has been for me.

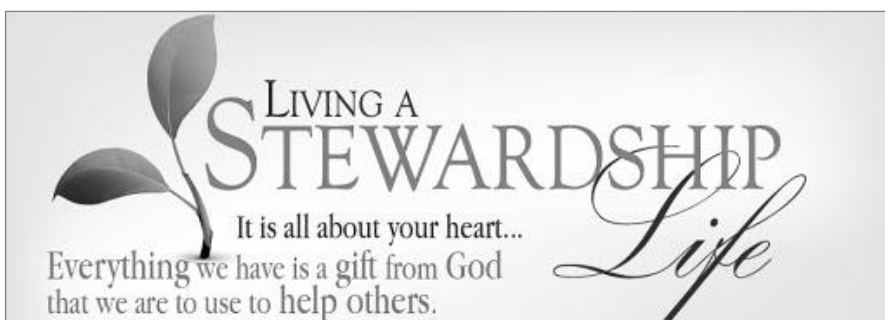

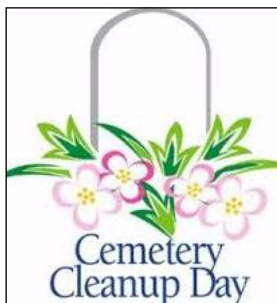
