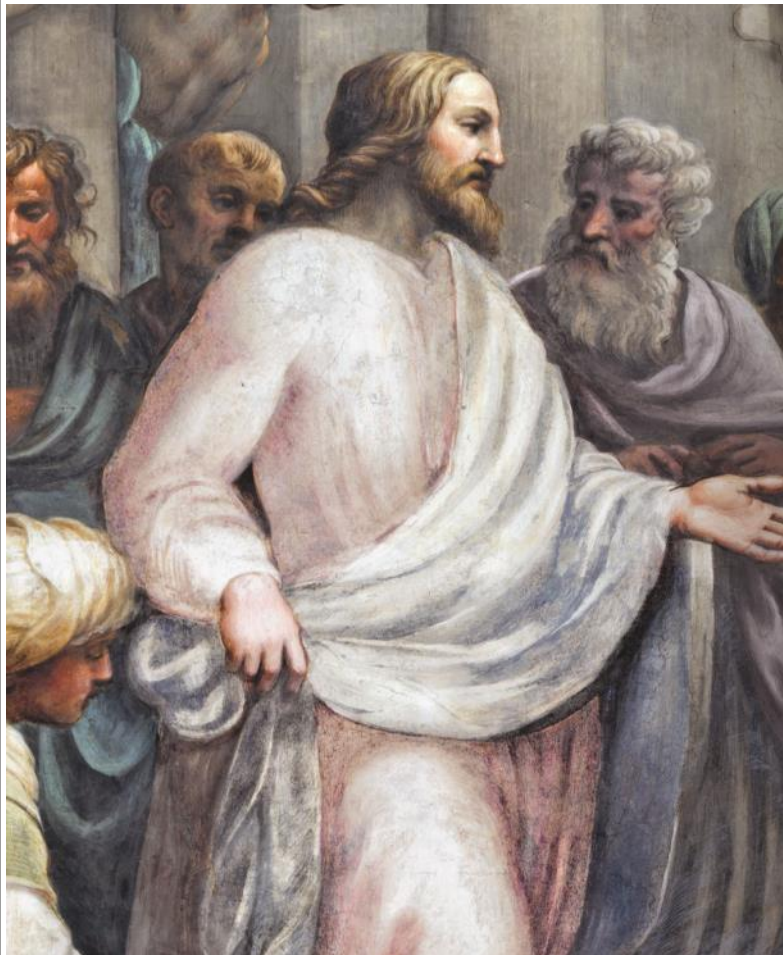

Dear Friends in Christ,

We are working on refreshing our outreach to the homebound. Please let the parish office know if you know someone who is homebound and would like to receive Communion. As well, we are looking for more Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion to the homebound. This could be a weekly visit to someone who is homebound, monthly, or even as a substitute. But we are in need of more Ministers to the Homebound. We may only appreciate the importance of this ministry when we find a loved one or ourselves unable to come to Mass in person. Perhaps consider it a way to pay forward what another will one day do for you. If you are interested, please contact the Parish Office.

As we move into September, and I am honestly not sure how time flies so quickly, we return once again to the theme of stewardship. This year we will invite you to reflect on the Lord's blessings and what it means to make a return to Him. To assist in this reflection, alongside the themes of stewardship addressed during the homilies, we will have some parishioners share how they live their stewardship as well as one form of stewardship being lived out in the work of this new program of ours, Foundations of Faith. We also have our annual stewardship report that includes a bit more than just the finances this year,

with a summary of our parish life as well as hopes for this coming year. On Sunday, September 12, we will have our annual Ministry Fair at the 10 AM Mass and on the last weekend of September, we will invite you to fill out a stewardship commitment card as a parish. This year we will not send out these cards in the mail but invite you to fill them out and place your card at the altar as a part of the liturgy at the time of the offertory. Lastly, you will be receiving a letter in the mail as an introduction to our month on stewardship. I pray that as we reflect on this critical piece of Christian discipleship and parish life, we may make this part of our way of thinking as followers of Christ.

I do appreciate everyone's feedback regarding access to the Holy Mass, with location, times, virtual offerings and on the radio, as well as taking proper precautions, and even the temperature. It is important to keep in mind that we are all at different places it all. It is where I'm reminded that the parish is kind of like a massive ongoing family reunion where everyone is all together and has different ideas and opinions on the best way forward and what we should be doing. None of them are necessarily wrong but we also have to stick together. If I could identify my role here I might be the unduly appointed reunion director who is not even sure how he got appointed. And I realize that no one

is ever quite perfectly pleased no matter the answer given for why we are doing things as we are. So I thank you for your patience and graciousness. I do thank the Lord that it is His family and He is really in charge. There is not much for us to have to make up or decide. God has given us all that through His Church. Rather, we must only work on some of these practical details.

My office door is always open if you have a concern or question. I will not always have the best answer but I will certainly be ready to listen, and as I do not know anywhere close to everything about anything, I will bring it to prayer.

I will say it also helps my own priestly ministry to know how the Lord has blessed you recently as well as why prayer is needed. It keeps my own heart at peace knowing despite the daily administration that seems to take up a good amount of time, the Lord is doing the work of saving souls. An email or note is always appreciated!
