Dear Friends in Christ,

We have finally entered into this Holy Week. Now is not a time to let up on our Lenten disciplines but persevere until the end. And supposing that some of our Lenten disciplines have been truly fruitful, we may consider continuing them. A habit of going to a daily Mass or praying the Rosary regularly or a couple cold showers a week can be a great form of spiritual sacrifice and growth. While Lent is a focused time, the entire year is a call to holiness.

Thankfully, this year we are able to celebrate our Sacred Triduum liturgies in public and you are invited to join us. Each of the liturgies on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday will be slightly modified according to the direction of our Bishop, Jaime Soto. But let us make good use of these holy days, reflecting either through the liturgy or in following along with the readings each day, of these events that are our hope and source of salvation. I will also be offering additional times for Confession this week if you have not yet had the chance to receive the Lord's forgiveness. On Thursday, they will be from 5 PM to 6 PM; on Friday, from 12 PM to 1 PM; and on Saturday from

the usual 3:30 PM to 4:30 PM. Keep in mind the Vigil Mass on Saturday is at 8 PM, not the usual 5 PM Vigil hour.

This might be a good time to invite someone to Mass. While we are limited on our space inside of the church building, we can also accommodate more in the hall. Or if you are still unable to attend in person, you may consider having a couple people over to watch these liturgies from home. You may have also noticed new faces at Mass these last months. Or perhaps not! Masks do make things a lot harder. However, we have had a number of new parishioners join our parish so do feel free to greet people, even from a distance. There is a good chance they might well be new.

Let us also continue to challenge each other to pray for each other and ask people what they need prayer for. It is honestly a hard habit to build but one that is quite fruitful. Just the other day, Paul, our Director for Youth and Young Adult Ministries, spoke with a Mom and her kids who had come by the parish center and asked them what they needed prayer for and prayed with them right on the spot. I am thankful for his example because it makes me realize how much more I have to grow in my

courage to invite people into prayer. Perhaps you have found it challenging too. Let us keep trying, together!

On a sidenote, I do hope many of you are keeping up with Fr. Mike Schmitz's "Bible in a Year" Podcast. We're on day 85 or so at this point and it has been a blessing to say the least. I know I have heard that from quite a few of you as well. If you have fallen behind, keep going! It only gets better. If you have not subscribed yet, consider doing so. If you need help figuring out how to listen to his podcast on your phone or computer, give the office a call and we will help you out.




