Dear Friends in Christ,

This is the week! We start our 40 Hour Devotion this Tuesday. Fr. Julius from Good Shepherd in Elk Grove will join me in hearing Confessions at 6:30PM. I hope you will join us. We are a parish rooted in prayer and focused on living in deep intimate relationship with Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. I pray you will find a moment to come and spend time with the Lord. I am always impressed by those both young and old who take time, especially at those odd hours of the night and morning, to stay with the Lord.

Pope Benedict Emeritus reminds us: *"Only by adoring this presence do we learn how to receive Him properly. ... Let us love being with the Lord! There we can speak with Him about everything. We can offer Him our petitions, our concerns, our troubles. Our joys. Our gratitude, our disappointments, our needs and our aspirations. There we can also constantly ask Him: 'Lord send laborers into Your harvest! Help me to be a good worker in Your vineyard!'"*

As well he speaks of another part of prayer: *"There is another aspect of prayer which we need to remember: silent contemplation. Saint John, for example, tells us that to embrace God's revelation we must first listen, then respond by proclaiming what we have heard and*

seen (cf. 1 Jn 1:2-3; Dei Verbum Pope Paul VI 1965). Have we perhaps lost something of the art of listening? Do you leave space to hear God's whisper, calling you forth into goodness? Friends, do not be afraid of silence or stillness, listen to God, adore him in the Eucharist. Let his word shape your journey as an unfolding of holiness."

While we encourage people to take a whole hour, even dropping by for 15 minutes can be great. If you don't know what to do, spend some time speaking with the Lord about what weighs on your heart or read the readings for the day and ask the Lord what He wants to say to you. It does not need to be complicated. The Lord doesn't need greatness in prayer. He just needs you! Perhaps Adoration is new for you. Give it a chance. You will be surprised how it changes your life.

Thank you to all who helped organize and assist with Deacon Jaime's thanksgiving gathering following his official retirement. Let us continue to pray for him.

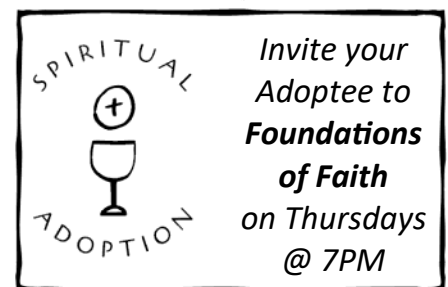
