Let us keep up our prayers for Fr. Relihan. He was back in the hospital last week and we are hoping he can do some acute rehab soon. I was able to visit him last Sunday and he was in good spirits.

You may or may not have seen in the official news of the Diocese if you read the regular distribution, but our Deacon Jaime Garcia submitted his request for retirement. This is always customarily done when a deacon reaches the age of 75 years old. Deacon Jaime did that this summer so a belated happy birthday to him! While retired, he will still be somewhat active so you will see him around, especially serving with SVDP, YMI, and the Knights of Columbus as well as at Sunday Masses. This is our last week reflecting on the Bread of Life discourse in chapter 6 of the Gospel of John. This last week is where the rubber hits the road. There is a reason why many of Jesus' disciples leave at just this moment. It is too much. They cannot believe in the Eucharist. We know there are others who won't follow either, or turn away, because the demands of discipleship are too great. We only need to recall the story of the rich young man who cannot give up the wealth he has obtained to follow Christ. What holds us back from surrendering to the way of Christ and living as a faithful disciple? Where do

we need to work on that spirit of detachment from the created things God has given us? What tension or resistance is there in our hearts about the demands of the Gospel?

As Pope Benedict XVI once said: "Are we not perhaps all afraid in some way? If we let Christ enter fully into our lives, if we open ourselves totally to Him, are we not afraid that He might take something away from us? Are we not perhaps afraid to give up something significant, something unique, something that makes life so beautiful? Do we not then risk ending up diminished and deprived of our freedom? . . . No! If we let Christ into our lives, we lose nothing, nothing, absolutely nothing of what makes life free, beautiful and great. No! Only in this friendship are the doors of life opened wide."

I will be away this week for a few more days of vacation visiting some brother priests. There will not be Mass Monday through Friday or Confession or Adoration on those days.

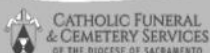
