Dear Friends in Christ,

Our Lawn Chair Chats of Summer have begun. Thanks to all who joined us for the first one. Our next one is a bit closer to the center of the county in Sutter Creek on Wednesday June 23rd. And then our third one is on Sunday June 27th. There is still time to RSVP and join us for either. Call the parish office or go on our website to register.

In the month of July there will be a couple different priests visiting to cover the Vigil Mass on Saturday as well as Confessions. So if you need Confession and prefer to go to another priest, Fr. Paul Macname will be here on Saturday July 10th and Fr. Memo Hernandez will be here on Saturday July 17th from 330-430pm.

We have recently added someone to our Parish Staff. We hired one of our parishioners, Ellen Waverly, to take on our Faith Formation program for the Kindergarten through 6th grade students and their families. Ellen, who many of you know, has been a parishioner for about 17 years and helped out in a myriad of ways, including as a Catechist, Lector, and Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion. Her husband Matt is probably a familiar face as well as he is a member of the Knights of Columbus as well as a sacristan and teaches for RCIA. Their children are also around quite a bit, having grown up in the parish. I am glad for her help in continuing

to grow our Faith Formation program as a means to reach more families and draw them into a deep and loving encounter with our Lord through the sacramental life. Dan Olenchuk has been serving in this capacity as coordinator for the last three years. As we are able to sing as a congregation together again, a reminder that we are called to sing in unison, as one Body in Christ, neither too fast or too slow, or too loud. We should sing in a way in which we can hear the voices around us.

Also, the Sign of Peace will make its return this weekend. As we are still required to take some precautions, we won't be extending a hand. However, here is a great moment of catechesis.

For the Sign of Peace is not a time to hug your family and greet your neighbor. It is not a ritual social call. Rather, Christ now being present on the altar, it is the peace of Christ that goes forth to us and we are invited to extend that peace with one another, we can receive Christ as one family. We do not extend that sign of peace first as husbands and wives, sons and daughters, but as brothers and sisters in Christ.

with His mother and brothers who want to bring Him home and He says to those He is speaking to, who are my mother and brothers? He then reaches out His hand to the disciples before Him and says, "Here are my mother and my brothers. For whoever does the will of my heavenly Father is my brother, and sister, and mother." It is a reminder that the greater bonds we have are as a spiritual family. So the sign of peace is a recognition of that spiritual family and therefore the sign should be the same to all. And since we are not currently hugging everyone, I would suggest the uniform greeting is a slight wave of the hand and the words "Peace be with you." This may seem foreign to us at first but until we can return to a handshake, this will have to do.
